RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Three(3) Pole limit per angler. (including bait pole)
2. Must be entered into regular OPEN DIVISION in order to participate in sidepots.
3. ALL ULUA catches must be called in IMMEDIATELY when landed. Hook and mainline must remain on the catch AND at least five (5) feet of MAIN LINE (60lb test max) remaining above the rig. Any catch not called in will be disqualified this rule goes for slide bait AND baitcast. Other categories do NOT need to be called in.
CALL IN 24 HOUR HOTLINE – 808-636-8585
A GTMasters official will come to verify catch within 2hrs. of call in.
Anglers MUST answer return phone calls from GTMasters hotline phone number. (stay within phone service boundaries while waiting for GTMasters Officials to arrive)
Flag included in contestants packets must be displayed on angler vehicle or visible at campsite to aid in locating fish.
4. 60 lbs. test maximum allowed for the main line. Anything over will result in disqualification.
5. Hang- bait method is NOT allowed.
6. Entrant can qualify only one (1) fish per category. Five pound (5 lbs.) minimum qualifying weight.
7. All near shore islands are off limits.
8. Being dropped off by boat is prohibited.
9. All anglers must fish from the shoreline (of Oahu); this shoreline must be accessible by foot.
10. Only shore casting is permitted. Any other means of casting is prohibited (flotation devices, swimming out, boat/kayaking/surfboards, etc....) **any flotation device on fishing site can and will cause disqualification.** Walking pole is legal.
11. Take care of your catch; make sure it is properly iced. Fish will be disqualified if it is spoiled, frozen, mutilated or bitten by a shark.
12. Each angler is responsible for casting his/or her own fishing pole.
13. In the event of tie, The first angler to weigh in will be the winner. (identical weights& fork lengths)
14. The tournament weight master is the official time keeper, and will determine the closing time of the scales. Please allow yourself sufficient time to be checked in by 1:00 pm. You will be disqualified, if determined by the weight master, that you are late.
15. The tournament chairperson will address any disputes, prior to the closing of the weigh in time.
16. The Eastside Outkastaz Fishing Club reserves the right to deny any individual entry, in this tournament.
17. Absolutely **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** The Release and Indemnity Form must be completed.
18. All State and Federal RESTRICTED AREAS are “off limits” (to include Hickam Air Force Base, Pearl Harbor, Bellows, Kaneohe Base, including the reef runway).
19. The entrant is the only person qualified to retrieve the fish, from receiving the “strike” to bringing in the fish to the shoreline. A partner may only assist in gaffing the fish.
20. In the event that a fish has been entangled, and brought in on two different pole lines, the fish will be disqualified
21. Each angler must be present, submit his/or her own fish, and able to provide a picture ID upon request, to qualify at the weigh-in.
22. Alcoholic beverages are PROHIBITED at the weigh-in site.
23. ANYONE ENTERING THIS TOURNAMENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO ABIDE BY THE TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS. ANYONE FOUND TO HAVE DEVIATED FROM THE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THIS TOURNAMENT AND ALL TOURNAMENTS THEREAFTER HOSTED BY EASTSIDE OUTKASTAZ.
24. A Form 1099 must be filled out for prizes over \$500 or prize will NOT be awarded.
25. IT WILL BE GTMASTERS OFFICIAL’S FINAL CALL AS TO IF THE LOCATION OF A CATCH IS ACCESSIBLE OR NOT. BE PREPARED TO HIKE YOUR FISH OUT IF YOU ARE IN A SECLUDED AREA.
26. **It will be mandatory to fly GTMASTERS flag included in your confirmation packet to ease officials locating you. As well as other fishermen identifying competitors to report cheating.**

27. Hybrids will not qualify in any category. A Hybrid trevally will be verified at the discretion of the GT Masters weigh master and may be protested by the competitor. See below for competitor protest procedure.

PROTEST AND DISPUTES

All protest and disputes as to interpretation of these rules and regulations or application shall be decided by 3 Eastside Outkastaz members, 3 random tournament entrants, and the tournament Weigh-master. Any and all protest and disputes must be made known to the Weigh-master on Sunday April 10, 2011 at the weigh-in site. If the angler of any protested or disputed fish is not present, or unable to be contacted when the dispute is made, the disputed fish will be disqualified. ALL DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL.

IZUO BROS. \$1000 CASH BOUNTY

Izuo Brothers is offering a \$1000 Cash bounty for the biggest 100+ lb. Ulua that is brought in to weigh in. Fishermen will be automatically entered into this running once entered in the open division.

PRIZE MONEY AND JACKPOT DISTRIBUTION

Ulua Category 1st – 6th

Sponsor money will be awarded on a per place basis if there are not enough qualifying fish in the category; the remaining places prize money will be returned to the sponsor.

Sidepot Money- EACH category 100% payout of total sidepot fees received by club.

- 1st place 60%
- 2nd place 30%
- 3rd place 10%

In the event there are **not** enough qualifying fish, the remainder of the pot will be evenly divided among the qualifying catches in their respective categories.

(Example: There is \$200 in the side pot and there are only TWO qualifying fish. The 1st place 60% will get \$120, 2nd place 30% will get \$60 and the remaining \$20 will be split evenly. Thus, 1st and 2nd place winners will have \$10 added to their pot.)

In the event there are no qualifying fish, there will be no refund and the money will be transferred to club funds. (Example: \$200 will go to the club.)

Prize distribution example: All prizes not awarded will be drawn by GT ID# (lucky number). You must be present to win with official GT ID badge.



NOAA BARBLESS HOOK CATEGORY

Hawaii's fisheries are of great concern to all of us who utilize our precious resource. Our fisheries are changing and we face new challenges daily. We can all help the resource by trying new methods or ideas that can help the fish or other creatures. We as responsible fishermen can make a difference, therefore we are encouraging all to consider using barbless circle hooks during this tournament. Using barbless circle hooks can result in less injury and facilitate catch/tag and release practices while maintaining its effectiveness when catching fish for home consumption.

Within the last several years, results from both tournaments and individuals, have proven that these hooks do indeed catch fish. The National Marine Fisheries Service, has also conducted research, concluding that the barbless hooks are equally effective as that of a barbed hook.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The "Honor System" will be in force during this tournament.

Anglers must be entered in the "Izuo Brothers GT Masters" to participate in the barbless hook category.

Anglers must declare their intention to participate in the barbless circle hook category upon entry into the tournament by putting an "X" next to the barbless hook category on entry blank.

Anglers must use a barbless circle hook to catch qualifying fish. The barb must be either crushed down or filed off, to render it "barbless"

Eligible fish species and sizes are limited to those identified as qualifying under the general tournament rules..

Do not remove the barbless circle hook from the fish, The hook must be present to qualify the catch. Prior to weighing in your fish please notify the committee of your entry status and identify your barbless caught fish.
